Dallas Historical Tour

The adult guest program provides your spouse or other adult guests an opportunity to explore Dallas while you're attending the conference sessions and exhibits. This year's program, a Dallas City Tour, takes guests on a guided tour of historic and modern day hot spots throughout the city.

The tour begins with a self-guided audio tour of the Sixth Floor Museum located in the Old Texas School Book Depository from where JFK was assassinated. Next, take a short walking tour of Dealey Plaza, the location of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy and the famous 9mm footage taken of the shooting death. While standing on the infamous "Grassy Knoll" guests will hear some basic theories that revolve around the death of the President.



Guests will also explore the Historic West End District of Dallas along with Victory Park, featured in Southern Living Magazine. Lunch will be served at RJ's Mexican Cuisine in the west end.

After lunch a driving tour visits Pioneer Plaza which commemorates the trails that brought settlers to Dallas and cattle to market. Drive by the original Nieman Marcus store, Thanksgiving Square, and make a stop at the renowned Dallas Farmer's Market. The Historic Swiss District, the next area of the tour, features some of the most exquisite early

20th century homes in the Southwest. Finally, discover the Cultural Arts District, which boasts the Nasher Sculpture Garden, the Meyerson Symphony Center, the Winspear Opera House and the Dallas Museum of Art.
