Tom Rutkowski's lab studies Unfolded Protein Response signaling, the regulation of cell fate by ER stress, the relationship between ER stress and metabolism, and the contribution of ER stress to liver disease. He has been in the ER field for over 20 years, first as a graduate student in the lab of Vishwanath Lingappa at the University of California, San Francisco, then as a postdoc in the lab of Randal Kaufman at the University of Michigan, and for the last 12 years as an independent investigator at the University of Iowa. He was the junior organizer for the previous iteration of this meeting in Snowmass, Colorado, in 2019.
