A Case in Point: Plant the Speed: From Plan to Plant

West Des Moines, Iowa is a city with a long-term technology vision. In 2016, it established a Strategic Plan, laying out a future where everyone in the city has access to fast and affordable internet. In 2020, the City Council approved a measure to build a city-wide open conduit network to help realize this goal. Google Fiber (GFiber) is the first tenant on that network, serving homes and businesses in the city with gigabit internet and beyond. Google Fiber's mission is to help all communities — big, small, urban, rural, and everywhere in between — get access to internet that's fast, reliable, fairly priced and open. Google Fiber's lowa journey began with the City of West Des Moines, and now construction on the project is nearing completion. ## **Local Focus: Permit Me to Deploy Fiber**

One of the biggest challenges facing new broadband networks is the paperwork, specifically the environmental reviews and permitting approvals needed before construction can start. Given that most networks will likely be deployed across a combination of state, federal, and privately owned land, and possibly Tribal-owned land, or access to railways, bridge/overpass infrastructures, pols or towers, ducts or conduits, or federal and state highways, the number of federal, state, and local agencies an operator must work with can be overwhelming.
